And, behold, seven other cows came up after them from the river, gaunt and thin; and stood by the other cows upon the brink of the river. 4. And the gaunt and thin cows ate the seven sleek and fat cows. And Pharaoh awoke. 5. And he slept and dreamed the second time; and, behold, seven ears of grain came up upon one stalk, plump and good. 6. And, behold, seven thin ears, blasted by the east wind, sprung up after them. 7. And the seven thin ears devoured the seven plump and full ears. And Pharaoh awoke, and, behold, it was a dream. 8. And it came to pass in the morning that his spirit was troubled; and he sent and called for all the magicians of Egypt, and all its wise men; and Pharaoh told them his dream; but there was none who could interpret them to Pharaoh. 9. Then spoke the chief butler to Pharaoh, saying, I do remember my faults this day; 10. Pharaoh was angry with his servants, and put me in custody in the captain of the guard's house, both me and the chief baker; 11. And we dreamed a dream in one night, I and he; we dreamed each man according to the interpretation of his dream. 12. And there was there with us a young man, a Hebrew, servant to the captain of the guard; and we told him, and he interpreted to us our dreams; to each man according to his dream he did interpret. 13. And it came to pass, as he interpreted to us, so it was; me he restored to my office, and him he hanged. 14. Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him hastily out of the dungeon; and he shaved himself, and changed his garment, and came in to Pharaoh.

16. And Joseph answered Pharaoh, saying, It is not in me; Elohim shall give Pharaoh a favorable answer. 17. And Pharaoh said to Joseph, In my dream, behold, I stood upon the bank of the river; 18. And, behold, there came up from the river seven cows, fat and sleek; and they fed in the reed grass; 19. And, behold, seven other cows came up after them, poor and very gaunt and thin, such as I have never seen in all the land of Egypt for badness; 20. And the thin and the gaunt cows ate the first seven fat cows; 21. And when they had eaten them up, it could not be known that they had eaten them; but they were still ill favored, as at the beginning. So I awoke. 22. And I saw in my dream, and, behold, seven ears came up in one stalk, full and good; 23. And, behold, seven ears, withered, thin, and blasted by the east wind, sprung up after them; 24. And the thin ears devoured the seven good ears; and I told this to the magicians; but there was none who could declare it to me. 25. And Joseph said to Pharaoh, The dream of Pharaoh is one; Elohim has revealed to Pharaoh what he is about to do. 26. The seven good cows are seven years; and the seven good ears are seven years; the dream is one. 27. And the

seven thin and gaunt cows that came up after them are seven years; and the seven empty ears blasted by the east wind shall be seven years of famine. 28. This is the matter which I have spoken to Pharaoh; What Elohim is about to do he shows to Pharaoh. 29. Behold, there come seven years of great plenty throughout all the land of Egypt; 30. And there shall arise after them seven years of famine; and all the plenty shall be forgotten in the land of Egypt; and the famine shall consume the land; 31. And plenty shall not be known in the land because of that famine following; for it shall be very grievous. 32. And for that the dream was doubled to Pharaoh twice; it is because the matter is established by Elohim, and Elohim will shortly bring it to pass. 33. Now therefore let Pharaoh select a man discreet and wise, and set him over the land of Egypt. 34. Let Pharaoh do this, and let him appoint officers over the land, and take up the fifth part of the land of Egypt in the seven years of plenty. 35. And let them gather all the food of those good years that come, and lay up grain under the hand of Pharaoh, and let them keep food in the cities. 36. And that food shall be for store to the land against the seven years of famine, which shall be in the land of Egypt; that the land perish not through the famine. 37. And the thing was good in the eyes of Pharaoh, and in the eyes of all his servants. 38. And Pharaoh said to his servants, Can we find such a one as this is, a man in whom the spirit of Elohim is?
