You shall be blessed above all people; there shall not be male or female barren among you, or among your cattle. 15. And Hashem will take away from you all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which you know, upon you; but will lay them upon all those who hate you. 16.

And you shall destroy all the people which Hashem your Elohim shall deliver you; your eye shall have no pity upon them; neither shall you serve their gods; for that will be a snare to you.

And you shall remember all the way which Hashem your Elohim led you these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you, and to prove you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep his commandments, or not. 3. And he humbled you, and let you hunger, and fed you with manna, which you knew not, neither did your fathers know; that he might make you know that man does not live by bread only, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of Hashem does man live.
