Dan, and Naphtali, Gad, and Asher. 5. And all the souls who came from the loins of Jacob were seventy souls; for Joseph was in Egypt already. 6. And Joseph died, and all his brothers, and all that generation. 7. And the people of Israel were fruitful, and increased abundantly, and multiplied, and became exceedingly mighty; and the land was filled with them. 8. And there arose up a new king over Egypt, who knew not Joseph. 9. And he said to his people, Behold, the people of the children of Israel are more and mightier than we; 10. Come on, let us deal wisely with them; lest they multiply, and it may come to pass, that, when there would be any war, they should join our enemies, and fight against us; and so get them out of the land. 11. Therefore they did set over them taskmasters to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for Pharaoh treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses. 12. But the more they afflicted them, the more they multiplied and grew. And they were mortified because of the people of Israel. 13. And the Egyptians made the people of Israel serve with rigor; 14. And they made their lives bitter with hard slavery, in mortar, and in brick, and in all kinds of service in the field; all their service, which they made them serve, was with rigor. 15. And the king of Egypt spoke to the Hebrew midwives, and the name of one was Shiphrah, and the name of the other Puah; 16. And he said, When you do the office of a midwife to the Hebrew women, and see them upon the stools; if it is a son, then you shall kill him; but if it is a daughter, then she shall live. 17. But the midwives feared Elohim, and did not as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the male children alive.

And the shepherds came and drove them away; but Moses stood up and helped them, and watered their flock. 18. And when they came to Reuel their father, he said, How is it that you have come so soon today? 19. And they said, An Egyptian delivered us from the hand of the shepherds, and also drew enough water for us, and watered the flock. 20. And he said to his daughters, And where is he? Why is it that you have left the man? Call him, that he may eat bread. 21. And Moses was content to dwell with the man; and he gave Moses Zipporah his daughter. 22. And she bore him a son, and he called his name Gershom; for he said, I have been a stranger in a strange land. 23. Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. 4. And when Hashem saw that he turned aside to see, Elohim called to him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here am I. 5. And he said, Do not come any closer; take off your shoes from your feet, for the place on which you stand is holy ground. 6. And he said, I am Elohim of your father, Elohim of Abraham, Elohim of Isaac, and Elohim of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon Elohim. 7. And Hashem said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people who are in Egypt, and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows; 8. And I have come down to save them from the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them out of that land to a good and large land, to a land flowing with milk and honey; to the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites. 9. And they said, Elohim of the Hebrews has met with us; let us go, we pray you, three days' journey into the desert, and sacrifice to Hashem our Eternal One; lest he fall upon us with pestilence, or with the sword. 4. And the king of Egypt said to them, Why do you, Moses and Aaron, take the people from their works? Go you to your burdens. 5. And Pharaoh said, Behold, the people of the land now are many, and you make them rest from their burdens. 6. And Pharaoh commanded the same day the task masters of the people, and their officers, saying, 7. You shall no more give the people straw to make bricks, as till now; let them go and gather straw for themselves. 8. And the quantity of the bricks, which they did make till now, you shall lay upon them; you shall not diminish nothing of it; for they are idle; therefore they cry, saying, Let us go and sacrifice to our Eternal One. 9. Let there more work be laid upon the men, that they may labor in it; and let them not regard vain words. 10. And the task masters of the people went out, and their officers, and they spoke to the people, saying, Thus said Pharaoh, I will not give you straw. 11. Go, get straw where you can find it; yet nothing of your work shall be diminished. 12. So the people scattered throughout all the land of Egypt to gather stubble instead of straw. 13. And the task masters hurried them, saying, Fulfil your works, your daily tasks, as when there was straw. 14. But he said, You are idle, you are idle; therefore you say, Let us go and do sacrifice to the Lord. 18. Go therefore now, and work; for there shall no straw be given you, yet shall you deliver the quantity of bricks. 19. And the officers of the people of Israel saw that they were in evil plight, after it was said, You shall not diminish nothing from your bricks of your daily task. 20. And they met Moses and Aaron, who stood in the way, as they came forth from Pharaoh; 21. And they said to them, Hashem look upon you, and judge; because you have made us loathsome in the eyes of Pharaoh, and in the eyes of his servants, to put a sword in their hand to slay us. 22. And Moses returned to Hashem, and said, Hashem, why have you done evil to this people? Why have you sent me? 23. For since I came to Pharaoh to speak in your name, he has done evil to this people; neither have you saved your people at all.
