### Chapter 23

13. And Balak said to him, Come with me, I beg you, to another place, from where you may see them; you shall see but the utmost part of them, and shall not see them all; and curse them for me from there. 14. And he brought him to the field of Zophim, to the top of Pisgah, and built seven altars, and offered a bull and a ram on every altar. 15. And he said to Balak, Stand here by your burnt offering, while I meet Hashem yonder. 16. And Hashem met Balaam, and put a word in his mouth, and said, Go again to Balak, and say thus. 17. And when he came to him, behold, he stood by his burnt offering, and the princes of Moab with him. And Balak said to him, What has Hashem spoken? 18. And he took up his discourse, and said, Rise up, Balak, and hear; listen to me, you son of Zippor; 19. Elohim is not a man, that he should lie; nor the son of man, that he should repent. Has he said, and shall he not do it? or has he spoken, and shall he not make it good? 20. Behold, I have received a command to bless; and he has blessed; and I cannot reverse it. 21. He has not seen iniquity in Jacob, nor has he seen perverseness in Israel; Hashem his Elohim is with him, and the trumpet blast of a king is among them. 22. Elohim brought them out of Egypt; he has as it were the strength of a wild ox. 23. Surely there is no enchantment against Jacob, nor is there any divination against Israel; according to this time it shall be said of Jacob and of Israel what Elohim has done. 24. Behold, the people shall rise up as a great lion, and lift up himself as a young lion; he shall not lie down until he eats of the prey, and drinks the blood of the slain. 25. And Balak said to Balaam, Neither curse them at all, nor bless them at all. 26. But Balaam answered and said to Balak, Did I not tell you, saying, All that Hashem speaks, that I must do?
