#### Chapter 19

18. And a clean person shall take hyssop, and dip it in the water, and sprinkle it upon the tent, and upon all the utensils, and upon the persons who were there, and upon him who touched a bone, or one slain, or one dead, or a grave; 19. And the clean person shall sprinkle upon the unclean on the third day, and on the seventh day; and on the seventh day he shall purify himself, and wash his clothes, and bathe himself in water, and shall be clean at evening. 20. But the man who shall be unclean, and shall not purify himself, that soul shall be cut off from among the congregation, because he has defiled the sanctuary of Hashem; the water of sprinkling has not been sprinkled upon him; he is unclean. 21. And it shall be an everlasting statute to them, that he who sprinkles the water of sprinkling shall wash his clothes; and he who touches the water of sprinkling shall be unclean until evening. 22. And whatever the unclean person touches shall be unclean; and the soul who touches it shall be unclean until evening.

#### Chapter 20

1. Then came the people of Israel, the whole congregation, into the desert of Zin in the first month; and the people abode in Kadesh; and Miriam died there, and was buried there. 2. And there was no water for the congregation; and they gathered themselves together against Moses and against Aaron. 3. And the people quarrelled with Moses, and spoke, saying, Would Elohim that we had died when our brothers died before Hashem! 4. And why have you brought up the congregation of Hashem into this wilderness, that we and our cattle should die there? 5. And why have you made us come out of Egypt, to bring us in to this evil place? This is no place of seed, or of figs, or of vines, or of pomegranates; nor is there any water to drink. 6. And Moses and Aaron went from the presence of the assembly to the door of the Tent of Meeting, and they fell upon their faces; and the glory of Hashem appeared to them.
