Chapter 21

21. And Israel sent messengers to Sihon king of the Amorites, saying, 22. Let me pass through your land; we will not turn into the fields, or into the vineyards; we will not drink of the waters of the well; but we will go along by the king's high way, until we are past your borders. 23. And Sihon would not allow Israel to pass through his border; but Sihon gathered all his people together, and went out against Israel into the wilderness; and he came to Jahaz, and fought against Israel. 24. And Israel struck him with the edge of the sword, and possessed his land from Arnon to Jabbok, to the sons of Ammon; for the border of the sons of Ammon was strong. 25. And Israel took all these cities; and Israel lived in all the cities of the Amorites, in Heshbon, and in all its villages. 26. For Heshbon was the city of Sihon the king of the Amorites, who had fought against the former king of Moab, and taken all his land out of his hand, to Arnon. 27. Therefore those who speak in proverbs say, Come to Heshbon, let the city of Sihon be built and prepared; 28. For there is a fire gone out of Heshbon, a flame from the city of Sihon; it has consumed Ar of Moab, and Hashems of the high places of Arnon. 29. Woe to you, Moab! you are undone, O people of Kemosh; he has given his sons as fugitives, and his daughters, into captivity to Sihon king of the Amorites. 30. We have shot at them; Heshbon is perished even to Dibon, and we have laid them waste even to Nophah, which reaches to Medeba. 31. Thus Israel lived in the land of the Amorites. 32. And Moses sent to spy out Jaazer, and they took its villages, and drove out the Amorites who were there. 33. And they turned and went up by the way of Bashan; and Og the king of Bashan went out against them, he, and all his people, to the battle at Edrei. 34. And Hashem said to Moses, Fear him not; for I have delivered him into your hand, and all his people, and his land; and you shall do to him as you did to Sihon king of the Amorites, who lived in Heshbon. 35. So they struck him, and his sons, and all his people, until none was left alive; and they possessed his land.
