Chapter 31

13. And Moses, and Eleazar the priest, and all the princes of the congregation, went forth to meet them outside the camp. 14. And Moses was angry with the officers of the army, with the captains over thousands, and captains over hundreds, who came from the battle. 15. And Moses said to them, Have you kept all the women alive? 16. Behold, these caused the people of Israel, through the counsel of Balaam, to commit trespass against Hashem in the matter of Peor, and there was a plague among the congregation of Hashem. 17. Now therefore kill every male among the little ones, and kill every woman that has known man by lying with him. 18. But all the young women, who have not known a man by lying with him, keep alive for yourselves. 19. And stay outside the camp seven days; whoever has killed any person, and whoever has touched any slain, purify both yourselves and your captives on the third day, and on the seventh day. 20. And purify all your garments, and all that is made of skins, and all work of goats' hair, and all things made of wood. 21. And Eleazar the priest said to the men of war which went to the battle, This is the ordinance of the Torah which Hashem commanded Moses; 22. Only the gold, and the silver, the bronze, the iron, the tin, and the lead, 23. Every thing that can stand the fire, you shall make it go through the fire, and it shall be clean; nevertheless it shall be purified with the water of sprinkling; and all that can not stand the fire you shall make go through the water. 24. And you shall wash your clothes on the seventh day, and you shall be clean, and afterwards you shall come into the camp.
