Chapter 5

1. And Hashem spoke to Moses, saying, 2. Command the people of Israel, that they take

out of the camp every leper, and every one who has a bodily discharge, and whoever is defiled by the dead; 3. Both male and female shall you take out, outside the camp shall you take them; that they defile not their camps, in the midst of which I dwell. 4. And the people of Israel did so, and took them out outside the camp; as Hashem spoke to Moses, so did the people of Israel. 5. And Hashem spoke to Moses, saying, 6. Speak to the people of Israel, When a man or woman shall commit any sin that men commit, to do a trespass against Hashem, and if that person is guilty; 7. Then they shall confess their sin which they have done; and he shall make restitution for his trespass in full, and add to it its fifth part, and give it to him against whom he has trespassed. 8. But if the man has no kinsman to make restitution to for the trespass, let the restitution for the trespass be made to Hashem, to the priest; beside the ram of the atonement, whereby an atonement shall be made for him. 9. And every offering of all the holy things of the people of Israel, which they bring to the priest, shall be his. 10. And every man's consecrated things shall be his; whatever any man gives the priest, it shall be his.
