Chapter 23

17. And the field of Ephron, which was in Machpelah, which was before Mamre, the field, and the cave which was in it, and all the trees that were in the field, that were in all the borders around, were made over 18. To Abraham for a possession in the presence of the Hittites, before all who went in at the gate of his city. 19. And after this, Abraham buried Sarah his wife in the cave of the field of Machpelah before Mamre; the same is Hebron in the land of Canaan. 20. And the field, and the cave that is in it, were made over to Abraham for a possession of a burying place by the Hittites.

Chapter 24

1. And Abraham was old, and well advanced in age; and Hashem had blessed Abraham in all things. 2. And Abraham said to the oldest servant of his house, who ruled over all that he had, Put, I beg you, your hand under my thigh; 3. And I will make you swear by Hashem, the Elohim of heaven, and the Elohim of the earth, that you shall not take a wife for my son of the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I live; 4. But you shall go to my country, and to my family, and take a wife for my son Isaac. 5. And the servant said to him, Perhaps the woman will not be willing to follow me to this land; must I need bring your son again to the land from where you came? 6. And Abraham said to him, Beware that you bring not my son there again. 7. Hashem Elohim of heaven, who took me from my father's house, and from the land of my family, and who spoke to me, and who swore to me, saying, To your seed will I give this land; he shall send his angel before you, and you shall take a wife for my son from there. 8. And if the woman will not be willing to follow you, then you shall be free from this my oath; only bring not my son there again. 9. And the servant put his hand under the thigh of Abraham his master, and swore to him concerning that matter.
