Chapter 12

1. And Hashem had said to Abram, Get out from your country, and from your family, and from your father's house, to a land that I will show you; 2. And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing; 3. And I will bless those who bless you, and curse him who curses you; and in you shall all families of the earth be blessed. 4. So Abram departed, as Hashem had spoken to him; and Lot went with him; and Abram was seventy five years old when he departed from Haran. 5. And Abram took Sarai his wife, and Lot his brother's son, and all their possessions that they had gathered, and the souls that they had gotten in Haran; and they went forth to go to the land of Canaan; and to the land of Canaan they came. 6. And Abram passed through the land to the place of Shechem, to the terebinth of Moreh. And the Canaanite was then in the land. 7. And Hashem appeared to Abram, and said, To your seed will I give this land; and there he built an altar to Hashem, who appeared to him. 8. And he moved from there to a mountain in the east of Beth-El, and pitched his tent, having Beth-El on the west, and Hai on the east; and there he built an altar to Hashem, and called upon the name of Hashem. 9. And Abram journeyed, going on still toward the Negev. 10. And there was a famine in the land; and Abram went down to Egypt to sojourn there; for the famine was severe in the land. 11. And it came to pass, when he came near to enter to Egypt, that he said to Sarai his wife, Behold now, I know that you are a pretty woman to look upon; 12. Therefore it shall come to pass, when the Egyptians shall see you, that they shall say, This is his wife; and they will kill me, but you they will keep alive. 13. Say, I beg you, that you are my sister; that it may be well with me for your sake; and my soul shall live because of you.
