### Chapter 13

5. And Lot also, who went with Abram, had flocks, and herds, and tents. 6. And the land was not able to bear them, that they might live together; for their possessions were great, so that they could not live together. 7. And there was strife between the herdsmen of Abram's cattle and the herdsmen of Lot's cattle; and the Canaanite and the Perizzite lived then in the land. 8. And Abram said to Lot, Let there be no strife, I beg you, between me and you, and between my herdsmen and your herdsmen; for we are brothers. 9. Is not the whole land before you? Separate yourself, I beg you, from me; if you will take the left hand, then I will go to the right; or if you depart to the right hand, then I will go to the left. 10. And Lot lifted up his eyes, and saw the valley of the Jordan, that it was well watered everywhere, before Hashem destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah, like the garden of Hashem, like the land of Egypt, as you come to Zoar. 11. Then Lot chose for himself the valley of the Jordan; and Lot journeyed east, and they separated themselves, one from the other. 12. Abram lived in the land of Canaan, and Lot lived in the cities of the plain, and pitched his tent toward Sodom. 13. But the men of Sodom were exceedingly wicked and sinners before Hashem. 14. And Hashem said to Abram, after Lot was separated from him, Lift up now your eyes, and look from the place where you are to the north, and to the south, and to the east, and to the west; 15. For all the land which you see, to you will I give it, and to your seed forever. 16. And I will make your seed as the dust of the earth; so that if a man can count the dust of the earth, then shall your seed also be counted. 17. Arise, walk through the land in its length and in its breadth; for I will give it to you. 18. Then Abram removed his tent, and came and lived in the plain of Mamre, which is in Hebron, and built there an altar to Hashem.
