#### Chapter 17

7. And I will establish my covenant between me and you and your seed after you in their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be a Elohim to you, and to your seed after you. 8. And I will give to you, and to your seed after you, the land where you are a stranger, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession; and I will be their Elohim. 9. And Elohim said to Abraham, You shall keep my covenant therefore, you, and your seed after you in their generations. 10. This is my covenant, which you shall keep, between me and you and your seed after you; Every male child among you shall be circumcised. 11. And you shall circumcise the flesh of your foreskin; and it shall be a sign

of the covenant between me and you. 12. And he who is eight days old shall be circumcised among you, every male child in your generations, he who is born in the house, or bought with money from any stranger, who is not of your seed. 13. He who is born in your house, and he who is bought with your money, must be circumcised; and my covenant shall be in your flesh for an everlasting covenant. 14. And the uncircumcised male child whose flesh of his foreskin is not circumcised, that soul shall be cut off from his people; he has broken my covenant. 15. And Elohim said to Abraham, As for Sarai your wife, you shall not call her name Sarai, but Sarah shall her name be. 16. And I will bless her, and give you a son also of her; and I will bless her, and she shall be a mother of nations; kings of people shall be of her. 17. Then Abraham fell upon his face, and laughed, and said in his heart, Shall a child be born to him who is a hundred years old? and shall Sarah, who is ninety years old, bear? 18. And Abraham said to Elohim, O that Ishmael might live in your presence! 19. And Elohim said, Sarah your wife shall bear you a son indeed; and you shall call his name Isaac; and I will establish my covenant with him for an everlasting covenant, and with his seed after him. 20. And as for Ishmael, I have heard you; Behold, I have blessed him, and will make him fruitful, and will multiply him exceedingly; twelve princes shall he father, and I will make him a great nation. 21. But my covenant will I establish with Isaac, whom Sarah shall bear to you at this set time in the next year. 22. And he left off talking with him, and Elohim went up from Abraham. 23. And Abraham took Ishmael his son, and all who were born in his house, and all who were bought with his money, every male among the men of Abraham's house; and circumcised the flesh of their foreskin in the same day, as Elohim had said to him. 24. And Abraham was ninety years old and nine, when he was circumcised in the flesh of his foreskin. 25. And Ishmael his son was thirteen years old, when he was circumcised in the flesh of his foreskin. 26. In the same day was Abraham circumcised, and Ishmael his son. 27. And all the men of his house, born in the house, and bought with money from the stranger, were circumcised with him.
