Chapter 43

And he said, Peace be to you, fear not; your Eternal One, and the Eternal One of your father, has given you treasure in your sacks; I had your money. And he brought Simeon out to them. 24. And the man brought the men into Joseph's house, and gave them water, and they washed their feet; and he gave their asses provender. 25. And they made ready the present for Joseph's coming at noon; for they heard that they should eat bread there. 26. And when Joseph came home, they brought him the present which was in their hand into the house, and bowed to him to the earth. 27. And he asked them of their welfare, and said, Is your father well, the old man of whom you spoke? Is he yet alive? 28. And they answered, Your servant our father is in good health, he is yet alive. And they bowed down their heads, and made obeisance.
