Chapter 21

22. And it came to pass at that time, that Abimelech and Pikol the chief captain of his army spoke to Abraham, saying, Elohim is with you in all that you do; 23. Now therefore swear to me here by Elohim that you will not deal falsely with me, nor with my son, nor with my grandson; but according to the kindness that I have done to you, you shall do to me, and to the land where you have sojourned. 24. And Abraham said, I will swear. 25. And Abraham reprov'd Abimelech because of a well of water, which Abimelech's servants had violently taken away. 26. And Abimelech said, I do not know who has done this thing; nor did you tell me, nor have I heard of it, until today. 27. And Abraham took sheep and oxen, and gave them to Abimelech; and both of them made a covenant. 28. And Abraham set seven ewe lambs of the flock by themselves. 29. And Abimelech said to Abraham, What do these seven ewe lambs mean which you have set by themselves? 30. And he said, These seven ewe lambs shall you take from my hand, that they may be a witness to me, that I have dug this well. 31. Therefore he called that place Beersheba; because there they swore both of them. 32. Thus they made a covenant at Beersheba; then Abimelech rose up, and Pikol the chief captain of his army, and they returned to the land of the Philistines. 33. And Abraham planted a grove in Beersheba, and called there on the name of Hashem, the everlasting Elohim. 34. And Abraham sojourned in the Philistines' land many days.
