And it came to pass, when he heard that I lifted up my voice and cried, that he left his garment with me, and fled, and got him out. 16. And she laid up his garment by her, until his lord came home. 17. And she spoke to him according to these words, saying, The Hebrew servant, whom you have brought to us, came in to me to

mock me; 18. And it came to pass, as I lifted up my voice and cried, that he left his garment with me, and fled out. 19. And it came to pass, when his master heard the words of his wife, which she spoke to him, saying, After this manner did your servant to me; that his wrath was kindled. 20. And Joseph's master took him, and put him in the prison, a place where the king's prisoners were confined; and he was there in the prison. 21. But Hashem was with Joseph, and showed him mercy, and gave him favor in the sight of the keeper of the prison. 22. And the keeper of the prison committed to Joseph's hand all the prisoners who were in the prison; and whatever was done there, he was the doer of it. 23. The keeper of the prison looked not to any thing that was under his hand; because Hashem was with him, and that which he did, Hashem made it to prosper.
