Chapter 28

10. And Jacob went out from Beersheba, and went toward Haran. 11. And he lighted upon a certain place, and remained there all night, because the sun was set; and he took of the stones of that place, and put them for his pillows, and lay down in that place to sleep. 12. And he dreamed, and behold a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven; and behold the angels of God ascending and descending on it. 13. And, behold, Hashem stood above it, and said, I am Hashem the Eternal One of Abraham your father, and the Eternal One of Isaac; the land on which you lie, to you will I give it, and to your seed; 14. And your seed shall be as the dust of the earth, and you shall spread abroad to the west, and to the east, and to the north, and to the south; and in you and in your seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed. 15. And, behold, I am with you, and will keep you in all places where you go, and will bring you back to this land; for I will not leave you, until I have done that about which I have spoken to you. 16. And Jacob awoke from his sleep, and he said, Surely Hashem is in this place; and I knew it not. 17. And he was afraid, and said, How awesome is this place! this is no other but the house of the Eternal One, and this is the gate of heaven. 18. And Jacob rose up early in the morning, and took the stone that he had put for his pillows, and set it up for a pillar, and poured oil upon its top. 19. And he called the name of that place Beth-El; but the name of that city was called Luz at the first. 20. And Jacob vowed a vow, saying, If the Eternal One will be with me, and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat, and garment to put on, 21. So that I come back to my father's house in peace; then shall Hashem be my Eternal One; 22. And this stone, which I have set for a pillar, shall be the Eternal One's house; and of all that you shall give me I will surely give the tenth to you.
