Chapter 45

19. Now you are commanded to take your wagons out of the land of Egypt for your little ones, and for your wives, and bring your father, and come. 20. Also give no thought to

your goods; for the good of all the land of Egypt is yours. 21. And the people of Israel did so; and Joseph gave them wagons, according to the commandment of Pharaoh, and gave them provision for the way. 22. To all of them he gave each man changes of garment; but to Benjamin he gave three hundred pieces of silver, and five changes of garment. 23. And to his father he sent after this manner; ten asses laden with the good things of Egypt, and ten female asses laden with grain and bread and food for his father by the way. 24. So he sent his brothers away, and they departed; and he said to them, See that you fall not out by the way. 25. And they went up from Egypt, and came to the land of Canaan to Jacob their father, 26. And told him, saying, Joseph is yet alive, and he is governor over all the land of Egypt. And Jacob's heart fainted, for he believed them not. 27. And they told him all the words of Joseph, which he had said to them; and when he saw the wagons which Joseph had sent to carry him, the spirit of Jacob their father revived;
