#### Chapter 8

11. Beware that you forget not Hashem your Elohim, in not keeping his commandments, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command you this day; 12. Lest when you have eaten and are full, and have built goodly houses, and lived there; 13. And when your herds and your flocks multiply, and your silver and your gold is multiplied, and all that you have is multiplied; 14. Then your heart be lifted up, and you forget Hashem your Elohim, which brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of slavery; 15. Who led you through that great and terrible wilderness, where were venomous serpents, and scorpions, and drought, where there was no water; who brought you water out of the rock of flint; 16. Who fed you in the wilderness with manna, which your fathers knew not, that he might humble you, and that he might test you, to do you good in the end; 17. And you say in your heart, My power and the might of my hand has gotten me this wealth. 18. And you shall remember Hashem your Elohim; for he is who gives you power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he swore to your fathers, as it is this day. 19. And it shall be, if you do forget Hashem your Elohim, and walk after other gods, and serve them, and worship them, I warn you solemnly this day that you shall surely perish. 20. Like the nations which Hashem destroys before your face, so shall you perish; because you would not be obedient to the voice of Hashem your Elohim.

#### Chapter 9

1. Hear, O Israel; You are to pass over the Jordan this day, to go in to possess nations greater and mightier than yourself, cities great and fortified up to heaven, 2. A people great and tall, the sons of the Anakim, whom you know, and of whom you have heard say, Who can stand before the sons of Anak! 3. Understand therefore this day, that Hashem your Elohim is he who goes over before you; as a consuming fire he shall destroy them, and he shall bring them down before your face; so shall you drive them out, and destroy them quickly, as Hashem has said to you.
