Chapter 10

12. And now, Israel, what does Hashem your Elohim require of you, but to fear Hashem your Elohim, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve Hashem your Elohim with all your heart and with all your soul, 13. To keep the commandments of Hashem,

and his statutes, which I command you this day for your good? 14. Behold, the heaven and the heaven of heavens is Hashem's your Elohim, the earth also, with all that is in it. 15. Only Hashem took delight in your fathers to love them, and he chose their seed after them, you above all people, as it is this day. 16. Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your heart, and be no more stiffnecked. 17. For Hashem your Elohim is Elohim of gods, and Hashem of lords, a great Elohim, mighty and awesome, which favors no person, nor takes bribes; 18. He executes the judgment of the orphan and widow, and loves the stranger, giving him food and garment. 19. Love you therefore the stranger; for you were strangers in the land of Egypt. 20. You shall fear Hashem your Elohim; him shall you serve, and to him shall you hold fast, and swear by his name. 21. He is your praise, and he is your Elohim, who has done for you these great and awesome things, which your eyes have seen. 22. Your fathers went down into Egypt with seventy persons; and now Hashem your Elohim has made you as the stars of heaven for multitude.

Chapter 11

1. Therefore you shall love Hashem your Elohim, and keep his charge, and his statutes, and his judgments, and his commandments, always. 2. And know this day; for I speak not with your children which have not known, and which have not seen the chastisement of Hashem your Elohim, his greatness, his mighty hand, and his stretched out arm, 3. And his miracles, and his acts, which he did in the midst of Egypt to Pharaoh the king of Egypt, and to all his land; 4. And what he did to the army of Egypt, to their horses, and to their chariots; how he made the water of the Red Sea overflow them as they pursued after you, and how Hashem has destroyed them till this day; 5. And what he did to you in the wilderness, until you came into this place; 6. And what he did to Dathan and Abiram, the sons of Eliab, the son of Reuben; how the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up, and their households, and their tents, and all the goods that were in their possession, in the midst of all Israel; 7. But your eyes have seen all the great acts of Hashem which he did. 8. Therefore shall you keep all the commandments which I command you this day, that you may be strong, and go in and possess the land, which you are going over to possess; 9. And that you may prolong your days in the land, which Hashem swore to your fathers to give to them and to their seed, a land that flows with milk and honey.
