## Chapter 26

1. And it shall be, when you come in to the land which Hashem your Elohim gives you for an inheritance, and possess it, and live in it; 2. That you shall take of the first of all the fruit of the earth, which you shall bring of your land that Hashem your Elohim gives you, and shall put it in a basket, and shall go to the place which Hashem your Elohim shall choose to place his name there. 3. And you shall go to the priest who shall be in those days, and say to him, I declare this day to Hashem your Elohim, that I have come to the country which Hashem swore to our fathers to give us. 4. And the priest shall take the basket from your hand, and set it down before the altar of Hashem your Elohim. 5. And you shall speak and say before Hashem your Elohim, A wandering Aramean was my father, and he went down into Egypt, and sojourned there with a few, and became there a nation, great, mighty, and populous; 6. And the Egyptians dealt ill with us, and afflicted us, and laid upon us hard slavery; 7. And when we cried to Hashem Elohim of our fathers, Hashem heard our voice, and looked on our affliction, and our labor, and our oppression; 8. And Hashem brought us out of Egypt with a mighty hand, and with an outstretched arm, and with great awesomeness, and with signs, and with wonders; 9. And he has brought us to this place, and has given us this land, a land that flows with milk and honey. 10. And now, behold, I have brought the first fruits of the land, which you, O Lord, have given me. And you shall set it before Hashem your Elohim, and worship before Hashem your Elohim; 11. And you shall rejoice in every good thing which Hashem your Elohim has given to you, and to your house, you, and the Levite, and the stranger who is among you.
