Chapter 29

1. And Moses called to all Israel, and said to them, You have seen all that Hashem did before your eyes in the land of Egypt to Pharaoh, and to all his servants, and to all his land; 2. The great trials which your eyes have seen, the signs, and those great miracles; 3. Yet Hashem has not given you a heart to perceive, and eyes to see, and ears to hear, until this day. 4. And I have led you forty years in the wilderness; your clothes are not worn old upon you, and your shoe is not worn old upon your foot. 5. You have not eaten bread, neither have you drunk wine or strong drink; that you might know that I am Hashem your Elohim. 6. And when you came to this place, Sihon the king of Heshbon,

and Og the king of Bashan, came out against us to battle, and we defeated them; 7. And we took their land, and gave it for an inheritance to the Reubenites, and to the Gadites, and to half the tribe of Manasseh. 8. Keep therefore the words of this covenant, and do them, that you may prosper in all that you do.
