Chapter 21

22. And if a man has committed a sin deserving death, and he is to be put to death, and you hang him on a tree; 23. His body shall not remain all night upon the tree, but you shall bury him that day; for he who is hanged is accursed by Elohim; that your land, which Hashem your Elohim gives you for an inheritance, be not defiled.

Chapter 22

1. You shall not watch your brother's ox or his sheep go astray, and hide yourself from them; you shall in any case bring them again to your brother. 2. And if your brother is not near you, or if you know him not, then you shall bring it to your own house, and it shall be with you until your brother seeks after it, and you shall restore back to him. 3. In like manner shall you do with his ass; and so shall you do with his garment; and with every lost thing of your brother's, which he has lost, and you have found, shall you do likewise; you may not hide yourself. 4. You shall not watch your brother's ass or his ox fall down by the way, and hide yourself from them; you shall surely help him to lift them up again. 5. The woman shall not wear that which belongs to a man, neither shall a man put on a woman's garment; for all who do so are abomination to Hashem your Elohim. 6. If a bird's nest chances to be before you in the way in any tree, or on the ground, whether they are young ones, or eggs, and the mother sitting upon the young, or upon the eggs, you shall not take the mother with the young; 7. But you shall let the mother go, and take the young to you; that it may be well with you, and that you may prolong your days.
