Chapter 24

5. When a man has taken a new wife, he shall not go out to war, nor shall he be charged with any business; but he shall be free at home one year, and shall cheer his wife whom he has taken. 6. No man shall take the lower or the upper millstone as pledge; for he takes a man's life to pledge. 7. If a man is found stealing any of his brothers of the

people of Israel, and deals with him as a slave, or sells him; then that thief shall die; and you shall purge evil away from among you. 8. Take heed in the plague of leprosy, that you observe diligently, and do according to all that the priests the Levites shall teach you; as I commanded them, so you shall take care to do. 9. Remember what Hashem your Elohim did to Miriam by the way, after you came out of Egypt. 10. When you lend your brother any thing, you shall not go into his house to fetch his pledge. 11. You shall stand outside, and the man to whom you lend shall bring out the pledge outside to you. 12. And if the man is poor, you shall not sleep in his pledge; 13. You shall deliver him the pledge back when the sun goes down, that he may sleep in his own garment, and bless you; and it shall be righteousness to you before Hashem your Elohim.
