Chapter 30

15. See, I have set before you this day life and good, and death and evil; 16. In that I command you this day to love Hashem your Elohim, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that you may live and multiply; and Hashem your Elohim shall bless you in the land which you are entering to possess. 17. But if your heart turns away, so that you will not hear, but shall be drawn away, and worship other gods, and serve them; 18. I announce to you this day, that you shall surely perish, and that you shall not prolong your days upon the land, to which you are

going over the Jordan, to enter and possess. 19. I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your seed may live; 20. That you may love Hashem your Elohim, and that you may obey his voice, and that you may cleave to him; for he is your life, and the length of your days; that you may live in the land which Hashem swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them.
