Chapter 11

26. Behold, I set before you this day a blessing and a curse; 27. A blessing, if you obey the commandments of Hashem your Elohim, which I command you this day; 28. And a curse, if you will not obey the commandments of Hashem your Elohim, but turn aside from the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which you have not known. 29. And it shall come to pass, when Hashem your Elohim has brought you in to

the land which you are entering to possess, that you shall put the blessing upon Mount Gerizim, and the curse upon Mount Ebal. 30. Are they not on the other side of the Jordan, by the way where the sun goes down, in the land of the Canaanites, who live in the Arabah, opposite Gilgal, beside the terebinths of Moreh? 31. For you shall pass over the Jordan to go in to possess the land which Hashem your Elohim gives you, and you shall possess it, and dwell in it. 32. And you shall take care to do all the statutes and judgments which I set before you this day.

Chapter 12

1. These are the statutes and judgments, which you shall take care to do, in the land, which Hashem Elohim of your fathers gives you to possess all the days that you live upon the earth. 2. You shall completely destroy all the places, where the nations which you shall possess served their gods, upon the high mountains, and upon the hills, and under every green tree; 3. And you shall overthrow their altars, and break their pillars, and burn their Asherim with fire; and you shall cut down the carved images of their gods, and destroy their names out of that place. 4. You shall not do so to Hashem your Elohim. 5. But to the place which Hashem your Elohim shall choose out of all your tribes to put his name there, to his habitation shall you seek, and there you shall come; 6. And there you shall bring your burnt offerings, and your sacrifices, and your tithes, and offerings of your hand, and your vows, and your freewill offerings, and the firstlings of your herds and of your flocks; 7. And there you shall eat before Hashem your Elohim, and you shall rejoice in all that you put your hand to, you and your households, because Hashem your Elohim has blessed you. 8. You shall not do after all the things that we do here this day, every man whatever is right in his own eyes. 9. For you are not as yet come to the rest and to the inheritance, which Hashem your Elohim gives you. 10. But when you go over the Jordan, and live in the land which Hashem your Elohim gives you to inherit, and when he gives you rest from all your enemies around, so that you live in safety;
