#### Chapter 25

14. And if you sell something to your neighbor, or buy something from your neighbor's hand, you shall not defraud one another; 15. According to the number of years after the jubilee you shall buy from your neighbor, and according to the number of years of the fruits he shall sell to you; 16. According to the multitude of years you shall increase its price, and if the years are few, you shall accordingly diminish its price; for according to the number of the years of the fruits does he sell to you. 17. You shall not therefore defraud one another; but you shall fear your Elohim; for I am Hashem your Elohim. 18. Therefore you shall do my statutes, and keep my judgments, and do them; and you shall dwell in the land in safety.
