#### Chapter 25

25. If your brother becomes poor, and has sold away some of his possession, and if any of his kin comes to redeem it, then shall he redeem that which his brother sold. 26. And if the man have none to redeem it, and himself is able to redeem it; 27. Then let him count the years since he sold it, and restore the overpayment to the man to whom he sold it; that he may return to his possession. 28. But if he is not able to restore it to him, then that which is sold shall remain in the hand of him who has bought it until the year of jubilee; and in the jubilee it shall be released, and he shall return to his possession.
