Chapter 25

47. And if a sojourner or stranger becomes rich by you, and your brother who dwells by him becomes poor, and sell himself to the stranger or sojourner by you, or to the offspring of the stranger's family; 48. After he is sold he may be redeemed again; one of his brothers may redeem him; 49. Either his uncle, or his uncle's son, may redeem him, or any who is near of kin to him of his family may redeem him; or if he is able, he may redeem himself. 50. And he shall reckon with him who bought him from the year that he was sold to him to the year of jubilee; and the price of his sale shall be according to the number of years, according to the time of a hired servant shall it be with him. 51. If there are yet many years, according to them he shall give again the price of his redemption out of the money that he was bought for. 52. And if there remain but few years to the year of jubilee, then he shall count with him, and according to his years shall he give him again the price of his redemption. 53. And as a yearly hired servant shall he be with him; and the other shall not rule with rigor over him in your sight. 54. And if he is not redeemed in these years, then he shall go out in the year of jubilee, both he, and his children with him. 55. For to me the people of Israel are servants; they are my servants, whom I brought forth out of the land of Egypt; I am Hashem your Elohim.

Chapter 26

1. You shall make no idols nor graven image, nor erect a pillar, nor shall you set up any image of stone in your land, to bow down to it; for I am Hashem your Elohim. 2. You shall keep my sabbaths, and reverence my sanctuary; I am Hashem.
