Chapter 19

1. And Hashem spoke to Moses, saying, 2. Speak to all the congregation of the people of Israel, and say to them, You shall be holy; for I Hashem your Elohim am holy. 3. You shall revere every man his mother, and his father, and keep my sabbaths; I am Hashem your Elohim. 4. Turn you not to idols, nor make to yourselves molten gods; I am the Lord your Elohim. 5. And if you offer a sacrifice of peace offerings to the Lord, you shall offer it of your own will. 6. It shall be eaten the same day you offer it, and on the next day; and if anything remains until the third day, it shall be burned in the fire. 7. And if it is eaten at all on the third day, it is abominable; it shall not be accepted. 8. Therefore every one who eats it shall bear his iniquity, because he has profaned the consecrated thing of Hashem; and that soul shall be cut off from among his people. 9. And when you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not reap to the very corners of your field, nor shall you gather the gleanings of your harvest. 10. And you shall not glean your vineyard, nor shall you gather every grape of your vineyard; you shall leave them for the poor and stranger; I am Hashem your Elohim. 11. You shall not steal, nor deal falsely, nor lie one to another. 12. And you shall not swear by my name falsely, nor shall you profane the name of your Elohim; I am Hashem. 13. You shall not defraud your neighbor, nor rob him; the wages of he who is hired shall not remain with you all night until the morning. 14. You shall not curse the deaf, nor put a stumbling block before the blind, but shall fear your Elohim; I am Hashem.
