Chapter 14

1. And Hashem spoke to Moses, saying, 2. This shall be the Torah of the leper in the day of his cleansing; He shall be brought to the priest; 3. And the priest shall go out of the camp; and the priest shall look, and, behold, if the disease of leprosy is healed in the leper; 4. Then shall the priest command to take for him who is to be cleansed two birds alive and clean, and cedar wood, and scarlet, and hyssop; 5. And the priest shall command that one of the birds be killed in an earthen utensil over running water; 6. As for the living bird, he shall take it, and the cedar wood, and the scarlet, and the hyssop, and shall dip them and the living bird in the blood of the bird that was killed over the running water; 7. And he shall sprinkle upon him who is to be cleansed from the leprosy seven times, and shall pronounce him clean, and shall let the living bird loose in the open field. 8. And he who is to be cleansed shall wash his clothes, and shave all his hair, and wash himself in water, that he may be clean; and after that he shall come into the camp, and shall stay out of his tent seven days. 9. But it shall be on the seventh day, that he shall shave all his hair off his head and his beard and his eyebrows, all his hair he shall shave off; and he shall wash his clothes, also he shall wash his flesh in water, and he shall be clean. 10. And on the eighth day he shall take two male lambs without blemish, and one ewe lamb of the first year without blemish, and three tenth deals of fine flour for a meal offering, mixed with oil, and one log of oil. 11. And the priest who makes him clean shall present the man who is to be made clean, and those things, before Hashem, at the door of the Tent of Meeting; 12. And the priest shall take one male lamb, and offer him for a guilt offering, and the log of oil, and wave them for a wave offering before Hashem;
