Chapter 13

18. The flesh also, in which a boil was in its skin, and is healed, 19. And in the place of the boil there is a white swelling, or a bright spot, white, and somewhat reddish, and it is shown to the priest; 20. And if, when the priest sees it, behold, it looks lower than the skin, and the hair on it has turned white; the priest shall pronounce him unclean; it is a disease of leprosy broken out from the boil. 21. But if the priest looks on it, and, behold, there are no white hairs in it, and if it is not lower than the skin, but is somewhat dark; then the priest shall shut him up seven days; 22. And if it spreads much over the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean; it is a disease. 23. But if the bright spot stays in its place, and spreads not, it is a burning boil; and the priest shall pronounce him clean.
